

SES Spirit Beads

Each student will receive a welcome to SES bracelet with SES beads (and each new student will receive one at registration).

Each student will receive a bead for each year already completed at SES.

In subsequent years, each student will get 1 bead for completing the year (issued in June).

Criteria for Earning Special Beads

School House Citizenship Bead:

- Respects school rules (no incident reports over the course of the year)
- Demonstrates kindness (able to cite specific examples)
- Engages/is involved in school life (participates in at least 3 different extracurricular activities per year – ie. sports, EVB, Peer Mediators, Chess Club, Art Café, Choir, etc...)
- Demonstrates effort and perseverance in academics
- Demonstrates environmental awareness

Helping Hands Bead:

- Peer Mediator for the year and/or...
- Have demonstrated positive leadership in specific duties contributing positively to school life over the course of the year (ie. cafeteria helpers, door monitors, supervision helpers, etc...)

Art Bead:

- Participates in Art Café and/or the set design & construction of performances
- Consistent effort and helpfulness in Art Class
- Positive Role Model in Engaging and Supporting the Arts

Music:

- Actively involved in extra-curricular musical activities such as choir, rock band or vocal ensemble.
- Is a team player who encourages other students by their example of being cheerful, responsible, respectful and musical!

Math Bead:

- Represents SES at Math Competition(s)

Science/Tech Bead:

- Participates in Regional Science Fair at Université de Sherbrooke in either Expo-Sciences or the Tech Challenge.

Sports/Athletics/Health & Fitness:

- Participates in at least 3 noon-hour sports leagues
- Demonstrates great sportsmanship
- Demonstrates solid effort in class (Physical; Discipline; Mental; Homework)
- Arrives to PE/Athletics in gym clothes all but 4 times or less all year.

Graduation Bead:

- Each grade 6 student will receive a graduation bead at the end of June.

SES Positive Behaviour Bead:

- Each student who received 0 incident reports over the entire year.

Rules:

- Request bracelets not be worn to school on PE or athletics days.
- Students are responsible for their own bracelets and beads (we will not chase after lost or stolen bracelets or beads)
